Congratulations to Edward Elijah who is the Blind Employee of the Month and to Ga Yang who is the Sighted Employee of the Month for February. The amount of allowable monthly earnings (Substantial Gainful Activity) will increase to \$2,040, per month for people who are blind receiving Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) effective January 1, 2019. Tax Preparers will be at Lions Services each month during the month of March. Please coordinate with Management if you need assistance with tax preparation.
