Congratulations to Donna Pharr, Blind Employee of the Month and to Therese Kilem, Sighted Employee of the Month for November 2019. The amount of allowable monthly earnings (Substantial Gainful Activity) will increase to \$2,110, per month for people who are blind receiving Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) effective January 1, 2020.

HEALTH NOTE
